2023-2024 Black Women's Wall Street's Goals

- October 2023 Provide conference attendees with parting gifts (business & empowerment tools)
- December 2023 Begin digital promotion of 2024 Idea 2 Inception cohort open application phase
- January 2024 Vision Casting Luncheon for 2024
- March 2024 The Connect: Arlington Edition Networking Mixer
- May 2024 Business Training Class (open to public)
- June 2024 Begin Idea 2 Inception cohort (8 bi-weekly sessions)
- June 2024 The Connect: Collin County Edition Networking Mixer
- August 2024 Business Training Class (open to public)
- Sept 2024 Business Plan Pitch Competition (1st Place \$5,000, 2nd Place \$3,000, and 3rd Place \$1,000 along with in-kind donations from support of local community business services)
